It is also very much a topic of today, now that a total war has raged in Ukraine since 24 February 2022. Every day, the media confront us with the pointless destruction, death and ruin!

It emphasizes, once again, that peace and freedom are not to be taken for granted, but need to be kept up every day and, if necessary, fought for again.

It is YOUCEE's task, as imposed on it at the time by the Arnhem Veterans, to raise awareness in the younger generations.

Introduction

"Living with War" is the theme for 2023. It will be the common thread through all the commemorations, celebrations and other activities in relation to the Second World War. Every year, the distance to the Second World War grows, but everyone is confronted with the Second World War and other wars that have followed through the stories that are handed down from one generation to the next.

Telling stories about war experiences is often an important way to deal with what happened and to warn younger generations about the dangers of war. The impact of war is still felt in the lives of many people, both those who witnessed it first-hand, but also their partners, children, grandchildren and other family members. Younger generations also carry the experience of more recent wars, whether close by or far away. Some children and grandchildren of war victims struggle with questions about their own identity.



Introduction (cont'd)

YOUCEE uses the Battle of Arnhem as a starting point to a dialogue about war, peace, justice and international cooperation, and to comply with the wish of the Second World War veterans not to let the younger generations repeat the mistakes of the past, but to let them put their energy to better use. The aim of all this is to make young people realize that our freedom has been dearly bought and should be cherished, and that we should do everything in our power to prevent war and oppression. The war in Ukraine underlines the wish of the veterans and the importance of organizing this YOUCEE conference.
